Through the grace of God and generous support of many so far this year (January through October)....

#### we've raised over \$99,000 which covered 14,650 patient visits at BHP Clinic and employed 13 people in Haiti we traveled to meet and treat our Dominican and Haitian neighbors living in the Dominican Republic through mobile medical and arts clinics

we aim to raise \$50,000 before the year's end





Celebrating its 5th Anniversary this year, BHP Medical Clinic in north Haiti employs an all-Haitian staff of 13, is open 5 days per week, and treats 2,000 patients each month.

Your support goes directly to help our neighbors.

\$5 tests 38 patients for bladder infections
\$10 tests 17 patients for typhoid
\$25 provides complete medical care for a patient
\$50 provides 68 women with pregnancy tests
\$75 tests 85 people for diabetes
\$100 provides electricity for the clinic for 1 month
\$250 treats 10 patients
\$1,000 provides medication for 214 patients

\$11,000 complete operation of the clinic for a month

### evangelism

hope despite circumstances

BHP Medical Clinic Haiti employs two pastors who share the hope for true health and wholeness found in a relationship with Jesus Christ.

staff bible study is held daily before clinic opens

**a morning message** of scripture, hope and truth is shared with patients waiting to be seen

**community bible study** is held monthly, with currently over 60 participants

**street ministry** is done by pastors in order to meet and pray with neighbors in nearby villages

mission teams talk with patients outside mobile medical clinics, share daily devotional time with one another, on-ground staff and translators

changes a crisis mindset

As medical professionals in the clinic heal the physical body, artists, musicians, and evangelists spend time outside the clinic in the streets healing the mind and soul.

The arts have been proven to be one of the greatest antidotes to the negative effects of trauma on the brain, body, and spirit.

### A year-round arts program led by local artists at the clinic is part of our long-term vision.

Thank you for joining us in our mission to love our Haitian neighbors who inspire us by their joy and faith despite desperate circumstances!

Haiti is the **poorest nation** in the western hemisphere. Average annual income is **\$518** (\$55,000 in the US).

Only **50%** of the population has access to safe water. And only **25%** of the population has access to adequate sanitation.

Life expectancy in Haiti is 10 years less than the US.

**50%** of children do not attend school.

1/2 of the population is food insecure.

Haiti has **no elected leaders** and has been without a president since Moise's assassination in 2021.

Haitians living in the Dominican Republic also experience **poverty** and often **persecution.**
